Directions

From The South: Directions from the South, are quite simple. Once you get on I-90 going North, there is only one turn before reaching the town of Mercer. Take I-90 North, about 20 miles past Madison to Route 78/51. Take this exit going North past Minocqua about 25 miles to the town of Mercer.

Once in Mercer: Take Route 51 to the South End of Mercer. Turn East on Harper Street. You can't miss Harper Street as it's right next to the Mercer Chamber of Commerce's 30 foot loon statue. Take Harper Street one block to the T-intersection with Martha Lake Road. Turn right on Martha Lake Road and go about a quarter mile to a Left on Goettsche Road. Goettsche Road ends at the Pine Noel Resort main gate.

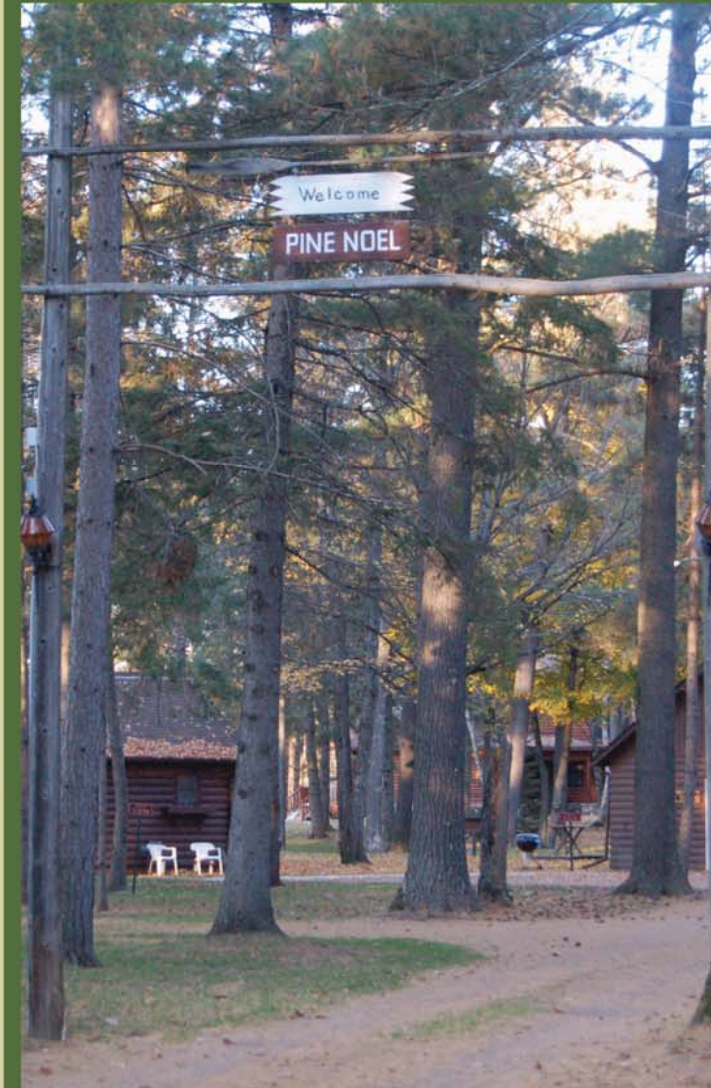

Why Choose Pine Noel?

Pine Noel is secluded and quiet, yet still within walking distance of the town of Mercer. Our five housekeeping cabins are nestled among towering pines with plenty of grassy area for relaxing in the sun. Linens are furnished and an aluminum boat is provided with each cabin rental. For your cooking pleasure, Weber grills and microwave ovens are included for each cabin.

The grounds are well maintained with several unique features such as a gazebo that's the perfect spot for an afternoon card game, a fire pit for evening gatherings, and a swing set that will provide the young ones with hours of amusement. The lake's sandy bottom slopes gradually making it ideal for swimming. A horseshoe pit and basketball hoops are great fun, as well.



Wildlife

The Mercer area is home to many species of birds and animals. Some of our more frequent visitors include deer, bald eagles, hummingbirds, and black squirrels. Watch the deer feed and eagles soar and possibly see a black bear in the great north woods. Walk to the many sounds of loons on the lake.

Fishing

Grand Portage Lake is an excellent spot for the fisherman. The 144 acre lake has panfish, bass, northern pike, walleye and the "Big One", the muskie. It is accessible from Pine Noel's own docks or from the aluminum boats that are provided with each cabin. (Motors available for rental, in town.)

Pine Haven sleeps 6 and has two separate bedrooms. One double bed, two twin beds, one pull-out double.



Pine Cone sleeps 8 and has a wonderful upstairs loft that is perfect for the kids! Two double beds, four twin beds. Knotty pine interior throughout, full-sized bathtub with shower and all new appliances in the kitchen.
